

## Travelling to Clifton campus: Students

### Travelling to university by car

There are limited parking facilities at our Clifton campus for students. Students whose term time address is outside our postcode exclusion zone of NG1-NG14 can purchase a parking permit from the NTU Online shop from the beginning of September. There is a limited number of parking permits available which are sold on a first come first served basis from the first week in September.

Students who live within the postcode exclusion zone and have extenuating circumstances are invited to email [cliftoncitycarparking@ntu.ac.uk](mailto:cliftoncitycarparking@ntu.ac.uk) for an application form.


Students with medical conditions or Blue Badge holders are invited to contact [disability.support@ntu.ac.uk](mailto:disability.support@ntu.ac.uk) who will assess for eligibility for a parking permit.

Students who live in New Hall accommodation are unable to bring a vehicle into Nottingham City under their lease agreement.

Students who live in Peverel accommodation can apply for a parking permit direct from UPP by enquiring by email to [peverell@upp-ltd.com](mailto:peverell@upp-ltd.com).

If you're travelling to Clifton campus by car and are unable to purchase a parking permit for on campus parking, we recommend you use the Clifton's park and ride services - **Clifton South Tram Park and Ride Forest (NG11 8BF)**. NTU student discounted return fare is £1.50.
