



NTU Covid Bursary 2020/21 Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Nottingham Trent University will be awarding a non-repayable NTU Covid Bursary to support full-time home undergraduate students impacted by the Government's COVID-19 lockdown restrictions during the 2020/21 academic year.
- 1.2 The NTU Covid Bursary will be paid during the 2020/21 academic year only and recipients will receive a single cash award of £200 in March 2021.

2. Eligibility

To be eligible for the NTU Covid Bursary, a student must, **on 15th March 2021**, meet all the following eligibility criteria:

- 2.1 Have been awarded a NTU Bursary for the 2020/21 academic year; AND
- 2.2 Continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the NTU Bursary as set out in the [NTU Bursary terms and conditions](#) relevant to their year of entry; AND
- 2.3 Have a household income level (as assessed by their national student finance service for the 2020/21 academic year) of £15,000 per year or less; AND
- 2.4 Have not received a [rent waiver in respect of Term 2 NTU or UPP accommodation fees](#).

3. Assessment, notification and payments

- 3.1 There is no separate application process for the NTU Covid Bursary. Bursaries will be allocated using information held by the University and the Student Loans Company for those existing NTU Bursary recipients whose NTU Bursary was approved on or before 15th March 2021.
- 3.2 Students identified as eligible for the NTU Covid Bursary will receive an email from the University, confirming their eligibility for the bursary, followed by a notification letter, advising of the date of payment.
- 3.3 The NTU Covid Bursary will be paid in a single instalment directly into the student's bank account. Payment will be made by the Student Loans Company, on behalf of the University, using the account details supplied by the student to the Student Loans Company.
