Coloured leaves for different questions (write on the coloured side)



You can discuss ideas and move them around



You can add more ideas as you go along,
simply write them on leaves



Point leaves at branches

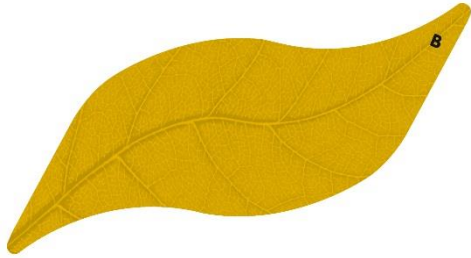


Cluster similar ideas





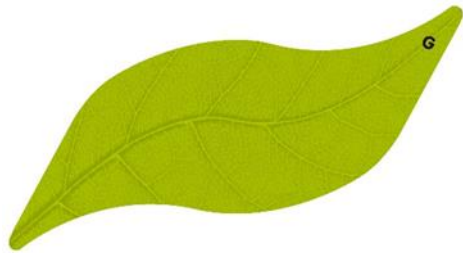
Leaves for ideas (Brown)

- What else do you need to develop further?

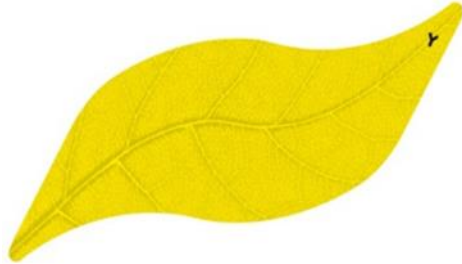
Leaves for ideas (Grey)
