

## MA Culture, Style and Fashion

**Your submission is an opportunity to showcase your work. We are looking for a variety of perspectives and a diverse study body to enrich our course, so please, respond to the following in the way that feels the most appropriate to you.**

In order for NTU to consider your application, you are required to submit a short essay illustrating your knowledge and perspective on an aspect of culture, style and fashion.

Either:

- identify and explore a recent trend in visual or material culture that interests you; or
- choose any aspect of style and / or fashion culture that puzzles or concerns you, that you have previously researched, or which you think deserves more critical attention.

Your submission should:

- demonstrate your writing ability (academic or journalistic);
- your sensitivity to images, surfaces or objects; and
- your interest / aptitude for developing knowledge, analytical and creative skills in the study of culture as it relates to style and fashion.

Your submission should be between 1,000 – 1,500 words maximum, and include images and a bibliography of sources you have used.

Please submit your work as a Microsoft Word file titled Culture, Style and Fashion essay.

### **What will happen next?**

The details of your application form and work submission will be carefully considered when assessing your application. We will use these to look for evidence of your knowledge of the fashion industry, your creativity, innovation and intellectual engagement. We will aim to inform you of a decision by email within 20 working days.

An electronic copy of your work submission will be retained by NTU for the duration of the annual application cycle, but will not be held on file for longer than this. Please ensure that all files sent to us are copies.

NTU will not use submitted work for any purpose other than the student application process.
