**Consultancy Experience Project:** Working as part of a team, you'll undertake focused research, developing your professional skills, managing a complex project and delivering results in a real business situation.

**Internship Experience Project:** On an internship of 12 weeks or more, you'll apply the theories you've learnt to a substantial, live project.

**Business Research Project:** This project is a traditional piece of independent research, creating an academic research paper, presentation and methodological reflection, this project is only available to students with significant prior work experience or a desire to progress to a PhD.

**Global Experience Project:** This exciting project gives you the opportunity to travel overseas and attend a summer school at one of our partner institutions.

As students of the Business School, the Link Lounge is your very own space in the home of Nottingham Business School. You'll find it on the seventh floor of the Newton building.


You can use the Link Lounge for:

## Nottingham Trent University named best for international students

Nottingham Trent University was named the best for international students in the Whatuni Student Choice Awards and ranked in the top ten universities overall.

The rankings, now in their third year, are based on thousands of reviews submitted by students and published on the Whatuni website.

Professor Nigel Healey, Pro Vice-Chancellor (International), said he was delighted the views of overseas students had led to a win in the International category.

"At Nottingham Trent University, we have put internationalisation at the heart of our new strategy, Creating the University of the Future. We have worked hard to welcome international students to our city, encourage home students to learn from them and celebrate our international diversity on campus. I am thrilled this work has been recognised by the WhatUni award."

The University also scored well across all ten categories, including being placed sixth for Students' Union and seventh in the Facilities section.

Overall, out of 125 universities in the Whatuni Student Choice Awards, Nottingham Trent University is ranked seventh.

Professor Eunice Simmons, Senior Pro Vice-Chancellor, said: "This is a ranking that we can feel rightly proud of, and one which reflects our ambition as we continue to implement our strategic plan."
