

Scope of NTU's EMS

NTU is one of the largest universities in the UK with over 42,997 students and 3,933 employees. It is a leader in delivering education and research that shapes lives and society for all staff and students. The University occupies over 100 buildings located over five campuses: City, Clifton, Brackenhurst and Confetti Campuses, and Mansfield University Centre, NTU's higher education offering out of Vision West Nottinghamshire College.

The scope of Nottingham Trent University's environmental management system has been determined to apply to all the buildings and land shown in the site plans for City, Clifton and Brackenhurst campuses.

As of 2022, the scope of NTU's EMS has expanded to include Confetti and Constellations, subsidiary entities acquired by NTU in 2016.

The scope includes all operations including the management of the estate and regeneration activities within all the schools and activities of professional services.

Constellations – "The provision of services in interior design, refurbishment, furniture manufacture and the supply and installation of creative technology."

The EMS scope does not include externally managed halls of residence or content of the curriculum, although NTU is fully committed to integrating sustainability into all courses through its Green Academy work.
