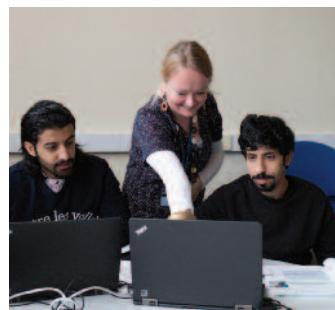

You can get free language support classes throughout your time as an undergraduate or postgraduate NTU student, including one-to-one help with writing.

Entry requirements

Visit www.ntu.ac.uk/englishlanguage for our language entry requirements. For most courses, this will be an IELTS academic test taken at an approved UKVI testing centre, grade 6 or 6.5 (or equivalent qualification).

If you need a visa to study with us, there are also minimum grade requirements in the skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing).

The length of a PEAP course you'll need to take in order to meet these requirements is decided on your current English level. For example, if you have an IELTS level 5.0 with minimum 4.0 in each skill, you'll need to do a 15 week PEAP course. Visit www.ntu.ac.uk/peap to see all PEAP entry levels.

Fees and course dates

How long you'll study for, and what you'll pay depends on your current level of English.
