

Your submission is an opportunity for you to showcase your work, skills and interests.

We would like to see examples of project work that you have undertaken recently. These will demonstrate the breadth of your critical understanding and a range of competencies within the field of design.

Examples of project work

These examples should demonstrate your design and art related abilities, and an interest in the Product Design subject area. You could include:

- evidence of the development of a design project from initial ideas through to finalised concept including examples of sketch work, prototypes and a visualisation of the final project outcome;
- examples of any art, design or technology related work you have undertaken;
- sketchbook images;
- photographs of models or 3D work you have made;
- use of CAD (Computer-Aided Design) software to develop or visualise your ideas; and
- idea development sheets.

Please submit these images in a PowerPoint presentation. It should be:

- no more than 20 slides (this will allow you to include more than one image of each piece of work, if required, plus short descriptions); and
- submitted as a single unzipped file not exceeding 10mb (megabytes)

NOTE: where images are inserted into the PowerPoint presentation they must be:

- in JPEG format; and
- a maximum of 72 dpi (dots per inch).



What we are looking for in your project work submission

- a quality and range of visual concepts, and level of innovative thinking;
- good presentation and the ability to visualise ideas;
- your ability to handle a variety of technologies, materials and processes;
- your willingness to experiment in a range of visual media; and
- good observational skills in drawing.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN NEXT?

When we receive your submission of work it will be reviewed by the course Admissions Tutor. Once a decision has been made on your application you will receive a notification through UCAS Track or an interview invitation from the University (if applicable).

It is essential that you submit your work by the given deadline, as unfortunately after this date we will be unable to consider your application and an unsuccessful decision will be communicated to UCAS.
