

Key Performance Indicator: Transport – Go2Uni4 Bus Service

NTU support and underwrite the Go2Uni4 Bus Service in partnership with Nottingham City Council and Nottingham City Transport. Passenger figures are reported annually.

Passenger numbers are recorded by Nottingham City Transport and weekly figures are passed onto NTU. The following table and chart show the passenger numbers recorded annually since 2005/06.

The recorded figures show a considerable increase in passenger numbers on Unilink over the past four consecutive academic years. The Unilink Service has improved significantly since 2005/06 when it ran every 20 minutes to now running at least every 7-10 minutes during peak and off-peak times.
