



Nottingham Business School Dean's Scholarship for Academic Excellence

Nottingham Business School will be offering a number of half fee scholarships that will be available to students who have an offer to study on the full-time Master of Business Administration for September 2020 entry.

These competitive scholarships up to half the value of the tuition fee will be awarded to candidates who most closely meet the criteria for the award, through their answers to the questions in section 2.

The scholarship decision will be made by an awarding committee and all decisions made by that awarding committee are final. The scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction and if you are awarded the scholarship your fee will be adjusted before enrolment. The scholarship will only be awarded if you meet the entry criteria for the Full-time MBA. Sponsored students (full / part) are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.

How to apply

Application process

Applications must consist of a fully completed scholarship application form and answers to the questions in section 2. These answers must be submitted as a written statement of 500 words.

The awarding committee reserve the right to exclude from consideration any applicants whose written statement exceeds the stated word limit or is incomplete. The awarding committee reserve the right to exclude from consideration any applicants whose written statement exceeds the stated word limit or is incomplete.

Application deadline

Applications received after the final deadline will not be considered. If we receive your application after 16:00 GMT (4 pm), we will consider it for the next deadline. If we receive your application after the final deadline, it will not be considered. We will contact you with our decision within four weeks of the deadline.

Terms and Conditions

Nottingham Business School Dean's Scholarship for Academic Excellence terms and conditions

1. Applicants are only able to apply once for the Nottingham Business School Dean's Scholarship for Academic Excellence.
2. Applications received after the deadline date will not be considered.
3. The scholarship is available to eligible UK, EU and international students who meet the entry criteria for the Full-time MBA starting in September 2020.
4. A scholarship up to the value of half the tuition fee is available although final amount of award will be at the discretion of the awarding committee.
5. If you are awarded any other scholarship, bursary or fee reduction from the University, the total amount awarded by the awarding committee will not exceed more than half the tuition fee.
6. If you have been made an offer of a place to study on the two year full-time MBA course which incorporates a year-long work placement, the maximum scholarship awarded will not exceed the value of half the Year One tuition fee, with the exception of candidates who are awarded a Sport Scholarship.
7. The scholarship will be available in the form of a tuition fee reduction. If you are awarded the scholarship your tuition fee will be adjusted before enrolment.
8. The scholarship is not transferable and will not be awarded if you choose to defer your entry to a different start date or if you choose to transfer to a different course at the University.
9. The scholarship will only be awarded if the applicant meets the entry criteria for the Full-time MBA, is made an offer by the University, accepts and meets the conditions of their offer and is eligible to enrol.
10. Scholarships are competitive and selection is based on the answers to questions in section 2. It is, therefore, of great importance that you give these questions careful thought and preparation and you refer to the criteria provided.
11. The University's decision in all matters relating to the scholarship is final.
12. If your scholarship application is successful, you may be asked to appear in online and / or printed University marketing materials. This may involve providing a student profile and a photograph which may be used to promote the scholarship scheme, or writing a blog.
