Applying to be a Homestay Host

Homestay accommodation tends to be aimed towards the International student market, although there are some students from the UK that may be interested. Typically a student does not sign a contract stating the length of their stay in the same way they would if they were renting a house or student halls; the student and host will make contact with each other and be able to negotiate the specifics of their stay between themselves. The rental payments will be **£85 p/w** for a self-catered service or **£120 p/w** for a catered service. The Student will pay the host directly – NTU will have no part in the collection of rent, but are available to provide advice and help if disputes arise.

HOST AGREEMENT FORM

As a homestay provider I/we understand that the students have a right to expect:

- To have a key to the house.
- That there will be a friendly and welcoming atmosphere at all times.
- To live as a member of the family.
- To be actively encouraged to speak English.
- To have the following minimum facilities in his/her room: bed, wardrobe, chest of drawers, adequate heating, extra bedding if required.
- Access to an area suitable for private study
- Privacy in his/her room
- The room and house to be clean and tidy.
- To be able to have a shower or bath at least once a day at agreed, mutually convenient times.
- To have access for his/her laundry done at least once a week
- To have breakfast and dinner and an optional light lunch on the weekend.
- To eat his/her meals with members of the family and household.
- Meals are to be served at regular times and Students are to be informed of when these times are.
- To be given sufficient food and a varied diet including a substantial portion of fresh food (including fruit and vegetables)
- That any particular and known dietary needs be met.
- To have facilities to make hot drinks as required
- To be able to have friends visit; by mutual agreement with the host.
- At least one week's notice if the student is required to leave their accommodation before the date specified at the time of booking with NTU
- To provide annual Landlord Gas Safe Certificate and Fire Risk Assessment (this is a legal requirement)
- Me to comply with the NTU 'Homestay Standards, Etiquette and accreditation'
