

## **Fee concession to University of Nottingham and University of Lincoln graduates**

For 2026 entry, Nottingham Law School is pleased to offer University of Nottingham and University of Lincoln graduates who commence one of the vocational law courses a concession of up to £750 on their tuition fee. This concession applies to the following courses:

- LLM Barristers Training Course (LLM BTC) (full-time)
- PGDip Barristers Training Course (BTC) (full-time)
- Postgraduate Diploma in Law Conversion Course (PGDL) (full-time and part-time)
- PGDip SQE1 Preparation Course (full-time and part-time)
- LLM Law Conversion and SQE1 (full-time and part-time)
- PGCert SQE 2 Preparation Course (full-time and part-time)
- LLM SQE 1 and 2 Preparation Course (full-time and part-time)
- LLM Law Conversion and Barristers Training Course (full-time)

Many University of Nottingham and University of Lincoln graduates start or continue their legal studies at Nottingham Law School. The two universities also work closely together providing workshops for skills training for law students and hosting the annual Law Fair. ## Professional Courses Alumni Discount

If you are an existing NTU final year undergraduate student, or if you have graduated from an NTU full-time undergraduate course or the Nottingham Law School PGDL and you enrol onto a Nottingham Law School full-time or part-time Professional Course, you are eligible to receive a tuition fee reduction of up to £1,000.

You must accept your offer of a place to study on an eligible course at Nottingham Law School starting in September 2025. You do not need to apply for the discount, as it will automatically be deducted from your fee before enrolment.

## University of Nottingham and University of Lincoln progression discount – Terms and conditions

### Eligibility Criteria

University of Nottingham ('UoN') and University of Lincoln (UoL) graduates who progress directly onto an eligible professional course at Nottingham Trent University ('NTU') may be entitled to a discount on tuition fees in the form of a fee reduction of up to £750 ('the Discount').

The UoN or UoL graduate must apply for the Discount by emailing [blsnlssubjectadmin@ntu.ac.uk](mailto:blsnlssubjectadmin@ntu.ac.uk) stating the course they are intending to start at NTU and evidence of their current course at UoN or UoL.

The UoN or UoL graduate may be eligible to receive the Discount if they are a UK, EU or international student and they:

- Graduate from a course at UoN or UoL in 2026; and
- Progress directly on to an eligible NTU course starting in September 2026 or October 2026.

NTU reserves the right to ask for a copy of the graduate's UoN or UoL certificate(s) to validate eligibility.

### Eligible courses

## Conditions

1. Applicants who are fully sponsored (tuition fees met) by their employers or a professional body are still eligible to receive the Discount and, for the avoidance of doubt, their tuition fees will be discounted accordingly.
2. Applicants who have obtained a bursary, which covers 50% or more of their tuition fees, are still eligible for the Discount on any remaining tuition fee.
3. If an applicant is eligible to receive the Discount and is also successful in receiving another scholarship or bursary from NTU, the Discount will be applied to their tuition fee after the scholarship or bursary amount has been deducted.
4. The Discount will only be applied once the applicant accepts and meets the conditions of their offer and is eligible to enrol on the course.
5. The full Discount will be automatically applied to the applicant's course fees upon enrolment. If the applicant fails to apply for the Discount by emailing [blsnlsubjectadmin@ntu.ac.uk](mailto:blsnlsubjectadmin@ntu.ac.uk), NTU cannot guarantee the Discount will be applied to their course fees upon enrolment.
6. The Discount is not transferable and will not be awarded if an applicant chooses to defer their entry to a different start date in a different academic year or if they choose to transfer to a different course at NTU.
7. NTU's decision in all matters relating to the Discount is final.

## Professional Courses Alumni Discount – Terms and conditions

### Eligibility Criteria

Eligible Nottingham Trent University (NTU) students who progress onto an eligible postgraduate course under NLS's Professional Courses Alumni Discount Scheme may be entitled to a discount on tuition fees in the form of up to £1,000 fee reduction.

You may be eligible to receive the Discount if you are an existing NTU final year undergraduate student, or if you have graduated from an NTU full-time undergraduate course or the Nottingham Law School PGDL and you enrol onto a Nottingham Law School full-time or part-time Professional Course.

You must accept your offer of a place to study on an eligible course at Nottingham Law School starting in September 2026. You do not need to apply for the discount, as it will automatically be deducted from your fee before enrolment.

NTU reserves the right to ask for a copy of your degree certificate(s) to validate your eligibility.

## Conditions

1. Students who have applied for a place on an eligible course that will be delivered on a modular basis must meet the above eligibility criteria and must have graduated with an academic award\* from NTU before enrolling on the first module of their course to be eligible for the Discount. Where an eligible course is delivered on a modular basis, the Discount applies to the entire course fee and is not available on a module-by-module basis.
2. Students studying on courses which are validated by, but not taught by NTU are not eligible for the Discount, except for Confetti students and students completing online (Wiley only) courses.
3. Students who are fully sponsored (tuition fees paid for in full) by their employers or a professional body are not eligible to receive the Discount.
4. Students who are partly sponsored and who meet the above eligibility criteria for the Discount will have the Discount applied to that part of the fees which is not being paid for elsewhere.
5. You do not need to apply for the Discount as it will automatically be deducted from your fee before enrolment if you are eligible. Please note, this can happen at any point up until the time you have fully enrolled onto your course and is not applied by a certain date in the year.
6. If you are eligible to receive the Discount and you are also successful in receiving another scholarship or bursary from NTU, the Discount will be applied to your tuition fee after the scholarship amount has been deducted. If you are awarded any other scholarship, bursary or other fee reduction from NTU, the aggregate amount awarded will not exceed more than half the tuition fee.
7. Students that have obtained a scholarship, bursary or other fee reduction, which covers 50% or more of their fees, are not eligible for the Discount on any remaining fee.
8. The Discount will only be applied once you accept and meet the conditions of your course offer and are eligible to enrol on the course.
9. The Discount is only available for students who have graduated from NTU with a qualifying academic award\*\* progressing onto an eligible professional course in accordance with the eligibility criteria. Students progressing from a postgraduate Masters level course onto another postgraduate Masters level course will not be eligible for the Discount.
10. Applicants due to enrol on a two-year full time Masters course which incorporates a year-long work placement are eligible to receive the Discount on their Year One tuition fee only. If you are awarded any other scholarship, bursary or other fee reduction from NTU, the aggregate amount awarded will not exceed the value of half the Year One tuition fee. The Discount is not transferable and may not be awarded if you choose to defer your entry to a different start date in a different academic year or if you choose to transfer to a different course at NTU which is not eligible for the Alumni Discount.
11. A student will only receive the benefit of the Discount once, regardless of the amount applied. If a student successfully completes an eligible course which has received the Discount and chooses to undertake another eligible course at NTU then the Discount will not be applied again.
12. Students are only eligible for the Discount if they are due to enrol on the first year of their course starting between 1 September 2026 and 31 August 2027. Students repeating their first year of study are not eligible for the Discount.

13. In the event that a student fails to complete an eligible course or withdraws from a course which has received the Discount and chooses to retake part or all of the course or undertake another eligible course then the Discount will not be applied again under any circumstances, regardless of the reason for not completing the course.
14. In the event that a student fails to complete an eligible course and the Discount was not applied at any time before or during the course (i.e., the student did not enrol and did not pay the tuition fees, or where the tuition fees were reimbursed in full) then subject to the eligibility criteria, the Discount may be available should the student- choose to retake the course or undertake another eligible course.
15. Should a student take an agreed, temporary leave of absence from their course, the alumni discount will still be valid when they return to their course, provided the course or any year of that course is not started again from the beginning.
16. Should a student withdraw from their course whilst owing a proportion of their tuition fees to NTU, application of the Discount shall be at the discretion of NTU and the Discount may be withdrawn.
17. International students participating in a foreign exchange programme with NTU are not eligible for the Discount.
18. The Discount for part-time students will be applied across each year of their course.
19. The University's decision in all matters relating to the Discount is final.
