Moving In

How to find us

Your email lists your specific residence address and contact details. Your residence team is contactable 24 hours a day.

For unloading, there is complimentary parking outside some residences. Please be aware that this is limited and does not apply to all halls – contact your residence team to find out more.



Checking in

You can check in after 2 pm on your scheduled day of arrival. If you are arriving outside of these hours, please call the residence directly.

Room keys can be collected from the residence reception.

Checking out

You will need to have checked out of your room by 10 am on your scheduled day of departure. Please return your key to the residence reception.

If you wish to extend your stay, you can submit a request in the accommodation portal by selecting 'Student summer accommodation' from the menu. Our team will review and allocate this subject to availability. For external guests, please email us at accommodation@ntu.ac.uk to make an enquiry.

WiFi

Free WiFi will be accessible throughout your stay.

Our service provider is Glide. You can register as a guest with them to connect once you arrive.

Laundry

Laundry facilities are available at the residence at an additional cost. You can download the relevant app, create an account and top up as needed.

What you need to know

Out of hours

Your residence reception is staffed 24 hours a day. During the evenings, we have Wardens and Facility Officers who will regularly inspect the building. If you have any problems and need to speak to someone, you can visit reception, call your residence contact number or get in touch with NTU Security at **+ 44 (0)115 848 2468**.

Support and contacts

The residence team offer 24-hour support and assistance, so there is always someone to contact to reassure you and answer any questions. You can also get advice and wellbeing support from our Student Accommodation Support Officers by emailing them at: **support4halls@ntu.ac.uk**

Post

Please direct all post to your residence reception at the address listed in your email.

Maintenance

In an emergency, contact a member of staff immediately. A need for repair usually results from normal wear and tear but we will claim back the cost of rectifying any deliberate, careless or accidental damage from those responsible (or from all residents if those not responsible cannot be identified).

Noise

Please keep audio visual equipment at an acceptable volume and close doors quietly. When returning to the residence, please keep noise to a minimum. If you should be disturbed on a regular basis and cannot resolve the situation yourself, please report the issue in the first instance to the residence reception. Please be considerate towards other residents and the local community and remember that noise levels are magnified at night.

Travel Information

Parking after arrival

Parking in Nottingham city centre is very limited. If you live outside of Nottingham city centre and plan to travel to the City Campus by car, we recommend using the city's Park and Ride services, as parking in the city centre can quickly become expensive. We recommend that you use one of the following Park and Ride sites:

- **The Forest (NG7 6AQ)**
- **Phoenix Park (NG8 6AS)**
- **Toton Lane (NG9 7JA)**

Please be advised that these are monitored and fines are issued to people parking without using the tram service.

Train

If you're planning on coming by train, you can get timetable information from **National Rail**. Nottingham Railway Station is a 20-minute walk from the City campus.

Tram

The City Campus is easily accessible by tram. We have our own tram stop right at the centre of the site. The stop is called 'Nottingham Trent University'. Bus

Nottingham City Transport (NCT) offer frequent routes across Nottingham, with buses running to all our campuses. Visit the **NCT website** to access the **NCT Journey Planner**.



Local Provisions

City – Local shops:

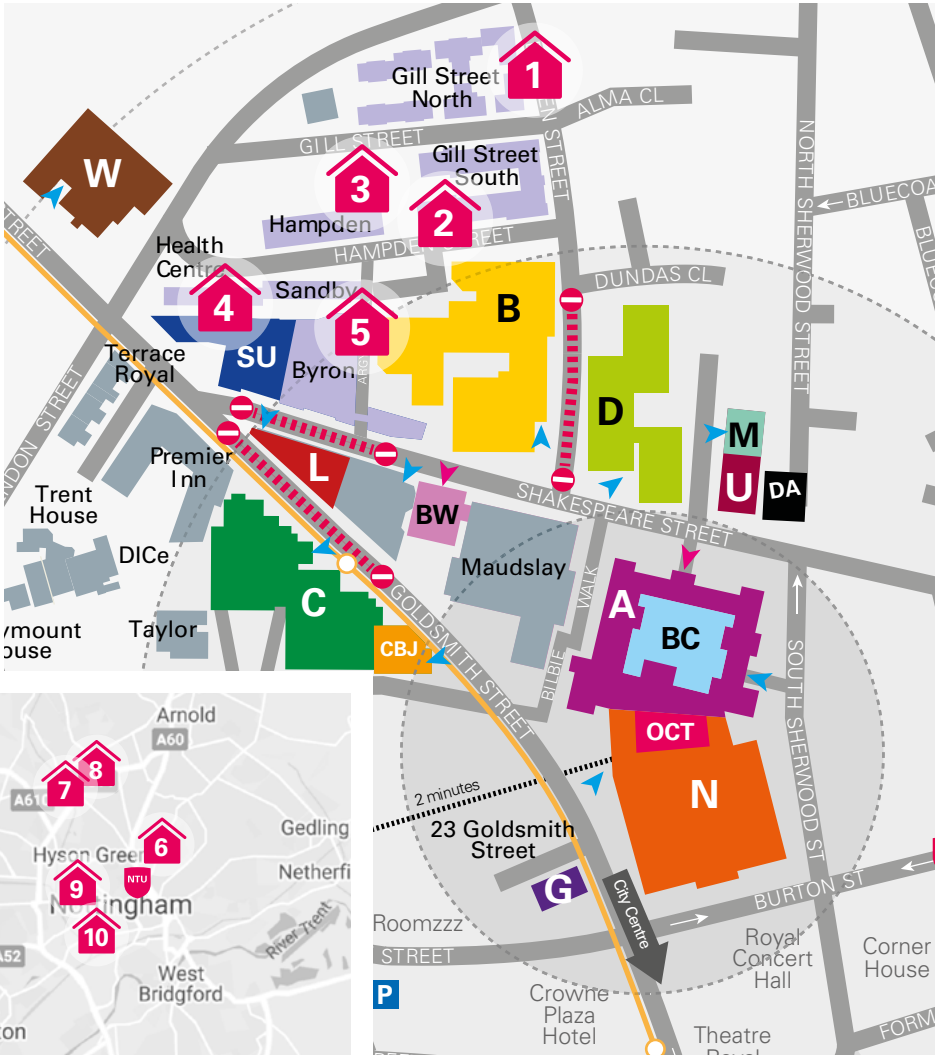
There is a small shop on campus called NTSU Shop which sells sandwiches and snacks. This is open 10am -4pm Monday – Friday. There are cafes on campus open Monday – Friday 8am – 4pm for drinks and light snacks.

Local supermarkets:

There is a Tesco Express on Shakespeare Street which is around a 5-minute walk from the Byron residence. For more variety, there is a Tesco Metro inside Victoria Shopping Centre, an 8-10 minute walk which is open 7 am – 11 pm Monday – Saturday and 11 am – 5 pm on Sundays.
