

## Dissertation

Credits from this 30-credit module can be put towards a PG Cert/PG Dip Advanced Social Work Practice or the MA in Advanced Social Work Practice. Applications are open to all registered social workers.

## Introduction

The module is aimed at social workers in all practice settings (Children's, Adult's and Mental Health Services) reflecting the generic nature of social work practice.

## Overview and Aims

This module will enable you to undertake an extended piece of critical and ethical research that builds on your pilot project completed in the pre-requisite Research Methods module. The module provides you with an opportunity to make an original contribution to knowledge and understanding in your chosen field of professional practice.

## Module Content

- Review of research design and methodology building on the recommendations of the pilot study (Research Module pre-requisite). The review process will enable you to incorporate material from your methodological report (pilot study) into your dissertation.
- Ongoing supervision from dissertation supervisor.

## Teaching

Teaching is delivered through lectures, group work, direct supervision, e-learning and experiential activity, usually at the City campus and is supported by a range of online learning materials and access to library resources for personal study.

## **Assessment**

This module will be assessed through an 8000 word dissertation.

## **Fees**

The modular fee for academic year 2018/19 is £765.
