

There are eight Labs in total: Wrap, Prop, Navigate, Repeat, Social, Colour, Cut Up, and Object.


Reading lists are assigned to each Lab to introduce ways in which research texts can be integrated into making.

INSCRIBE invites you to generate a reaction, opposition or response by working on top of, or in opposition to, some kind of easily available pre-existent surface or material, whether this is physical matter or the digital or virtual. The doubletake or backward glance of reconsideration is what can be instigated by this kind of intervention: the reader or audience is nudged towards looking again at what they have seen. Attention is thereby drawn to our assumptions or prejudices.




