Students that have been nominated by their home institution will be contacted before 30th April with a link to the application form via our Mobility Online service which should be completed no later than 1st May 2024

You must have completed a minimum of 4 semesters of the same subject at time of arrival. You must have an IELTS score of 6.5 or above (or proof of equivalent) You must have been working to a standard of a 2:2 or above (please see EPS conversion chart for details)

Application deadline: 1st May 2024
