

Leadership and Management – An Action Learning Approach

Credits from this 30-credit module can be put towards a PG Cert/PG Dip Advanced Social Work Practice or the MA Advanced Social Work Practice.

Introduction

This module follows logically on from the prerequisite Leading and Managing Social Work Services, and enables candidates to put their learning from that module directly into practice.

Overview and Aims

To enable practitioners and managers to critically apply and reflect on research and evidence in their own field of practice, through action learning and a project in their own workplace.

Module Content

- Application of theories in practice
- Models of reflection and their relevance for effective practice
- Theory and practice of working in action learning sets

Teaching

There will be four days of input through action learning sets where candidates develop and implement a project in their own workplace. The action learning set meetings are held at the university.

Assessment

A 4000 word report of project management, drawing on practice issues and how these were addressed.

Fees

The modular fee for academic year 2018/19 is £765.
