## The challenge

As part of the 'What Works? Student Retention & Success Programme':

To design an instrument that will provide an index of student engagement, 'belongingness', and self-confidence that can 'work' over time and across disciplines

## NSSE, AUSSE and similar instruments, such as the HEA Pilot

## Won't do this particular job, though they may be fine for others

#### Academic demand changes over time

#### The instrument

16 scaled items, Strongly Agree ... Strongly Disagree

4 of these are negatively stated, necessitating reverse-scoring

13 Demographic items

Piloted with 709 first-year students in 4 varied universities

#### 3 Scales:

- Belonging (6 Items, Alpha .76)
- Engagement (6 Items, Alpha .76)
- Self-confidence (4 Items, Alpha .72)

**Variance explained = 52%** 

#### First administration

13 universities participated

2841 responses from first-year students in Nov-Dec 2013

Technical characteristics of instrument almost exactly as pilot

#### 3 Scales:

- Belonging (6 Items, Alpha .77)
- Engagement (6 Items, Alpha .75)
- Self-confidence (4 Items, Alpha .74)

**Variance explained = 51%**
