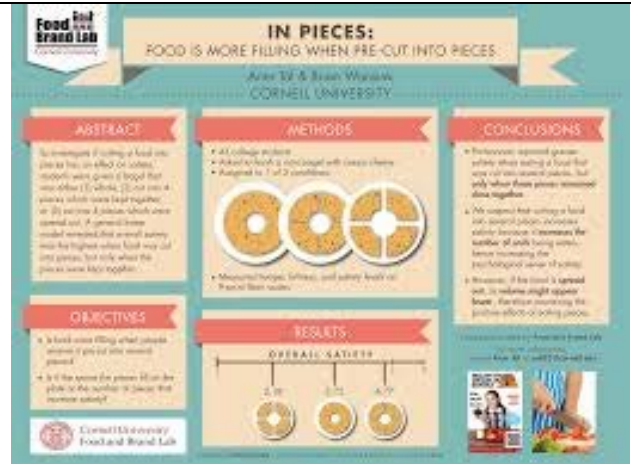


At the 2019 Research Festival we are having a display of both academic posters and research photos, and these will be displayed on electronic screens, rather than in hard copy, so you do not have to print your submission, just email it to Simone Apel. Please read on for the rules, application form and submission details.

Academic poster submission: The traditional academic posters, like the one shown opposite, are commonly seen at conferences and are a great way for PGR students to start to engage an audience with their research.

Design and produce your poster, don't forget to give it a title and add your name to it. Fill in the application form on the next page and email it, along with a PDF file of your poster, to Simone Apel by **March 15th**.

Research photo submission: Simply take a good quality digital photo which reflects or symbolizes your research and save it as a JPEG or TIF file. Give it a name, which **should be the title of your thesis**.

Email the file to Simone Apel by **March 15th**.

All the photographs submitted will be shown as a slide show, along with the digital posters, at the Research Festival.
