Public International Law	3	Full Year	20 (10 ECTS)	100% Coursework	Public International law is the system of rules regulating relations between states. The module will enable students to understand the way in which international society functions, encourage students to have a critical awareness of the relevant issues, to develop research skills, and to expound arguments in an original and coherent manner. This module will take you outside the bubble of UK law and provide you with a much more rounded understanding of the operation of law and international relations, which in turn may act as the real impetus behind our legislation.
