

Your digital portfolio submission is an opportunity for you to showcase your work.

For NTU to consider your application, you are required to include examples of your academic output. If you have experience of working in practice, you can include **5 extra pages** of work demonstrating your experience in practice.

You work can be in the form of images, drawing, photographs or other media.

You should include: -

- A supporting letter from your potential employer confirming that they will be supporting you throughout the duration of the apprenticeship,
- Primarily examples of academic studio work, including; research and conceptual stages, evidence of 3D modelling, and digital fabrication, studies and development of technical/environmental strategies and detailing
- The sheets should have succinct captions outlining the main project details (location, function, a short brief, narrative)
- 1 example of written/theory study. An essay or an excerpt from a dissertation will suffice
- 1 Example of professional studies

Please submit your portfolio as a PDF document: -

- Submit no more than 15 pages (20 if including examples of work in practice).
- Submit as a single file not exceeding 20 MB

Where images are inserted into the portfolio they must be: -

- In JPG format
- A Maximum of 72 dots per inch (dpi)
