Enjoy the day, and we hope to see you again soon.

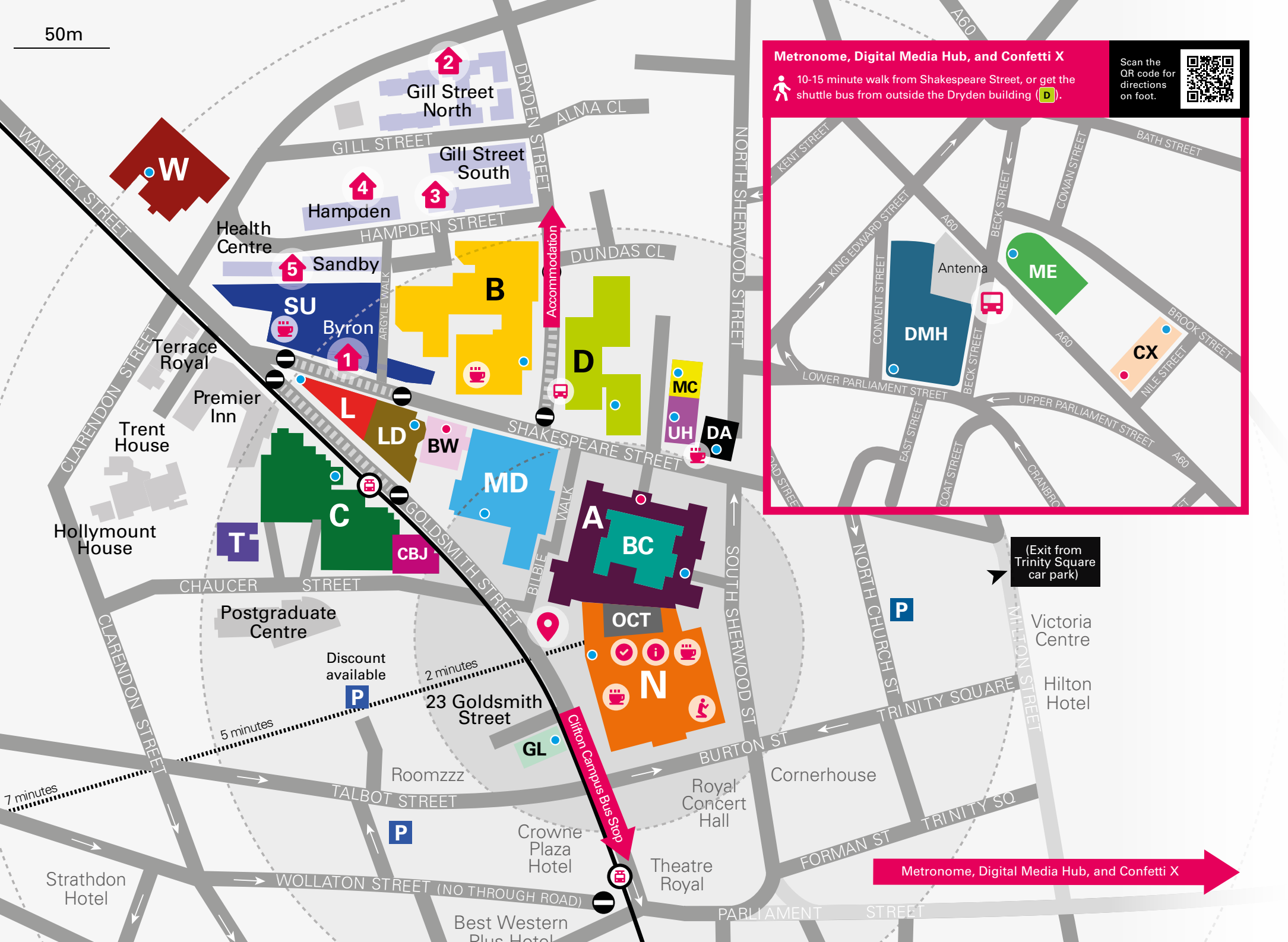

TRAVELLING BETWEEN CAMPUSES



City to Clifton:

- **By bus** (approximately 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.
- **By car** (approximately 15 minutes): Drive to Clifton using satnav postcode **NG11 8NS**. Free parking available on-site.
- **By tram** (approximately 40 minutes): Take the NET tram from Nottingham Trent University towards Clifton South. Alight at Rivergreen tram stop, then walk approximately 20 minutes to Clifton Campus.

City to Brackenhurst:

- **By bus** (approximately 45 minutes): Board the Lilac Line Pathfinder number 26 bus on King Street (K1). This service is not free, so visit nctx.co.uk for fares and timetables.
- **By car** (approximately 35 minutes): Drive to Brackenhurst using satnav postcode **NG25 0QF**.

Shuttle bus for Metronome, Digital Media Hub, and Confetti X:

- **On foot**: Metronome, Digital Media Hub and Confetti X are a 10-15-minute walk from Shakespeare Street. Visit the campus tours leaving point (📍) for help finding your way or scan the QR code on the campus map for walking directions.
- **By shuttle bus** (approximately 5 minutes): Take the free shuttle bus outside the Dryden building (D) from **8.40 am – 3 pm**. Buses depart approximately every 40 minutes.


