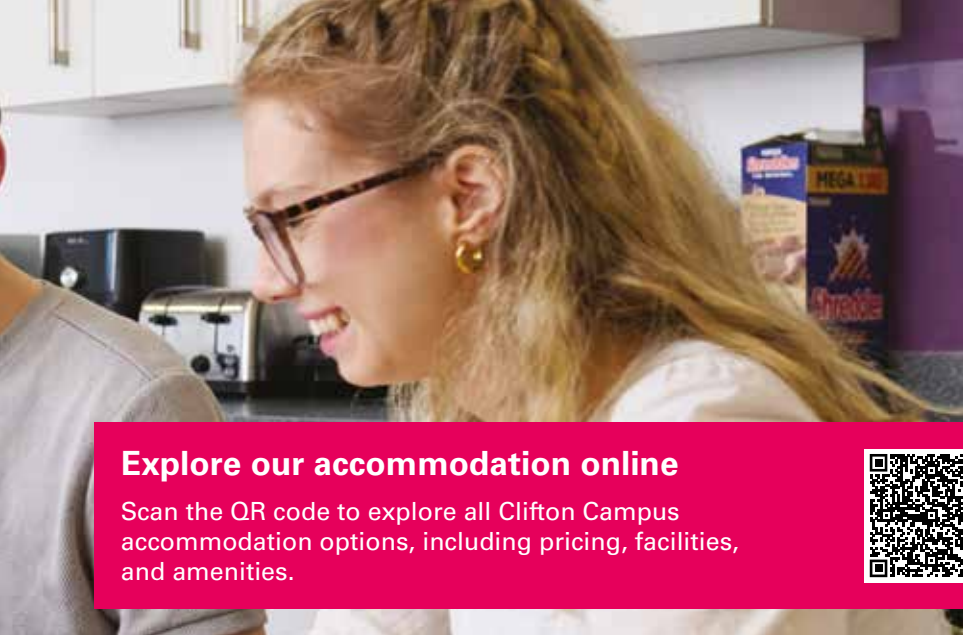
## Accommodation stand

# TRAVELLING BETWEEN CAMPUSES



## Clifton to City:

- **By bus** (approximately 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from the NTU Clifton (CL93) stop and get off at Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.
- **By car** (approximately 15 mins): The closest and largest parking facilities to our City Campus are:  
**Talbot Street (NG1 5GG)**  
**Trinity Square (NG1 4BH)**  
**The Victoria Centre (NG1 3PR)**

Alternatively, you could use one of the city's park and ride services and continue your journey by tram. The closest site to the city is The Forest (**NG7 6AQ**), which is approximately a 20-minute drive from Clifton Campus, and then a 5 minute tram journey.

- **By tram** (approximately 40 minutes): Walk 20 minutes from Clifton Campus to the Rivergreen tram stop. Alight at the Nottingham Trent University tram stop.

You must purchase a valid ticket to park and use the tram.

## City to Clifton:

- **By bus** (approximately 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.
- **By car** (approximately 15 minutes): Drive to Clifton using satnav postcode **NG11 8NS**. Free parking available on site.
- **By tram** (approximately 40 minutes): Take the NET tram from Nottingham Trent University towards Clifton South. Alight at Rivergreen tram stop, then walk 20 minutes to Clifton Campus.

## Clifton to Brackenhurst:

- **By car** (approximately 50 minutes): Drive to Brackenhurst using satnav postcode **NG25 0QF**. Free parking available on site.
