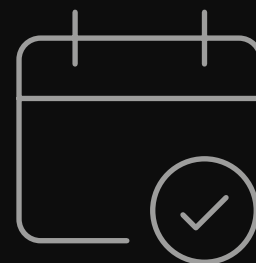


Welcome and congratulations for achieving a place on the 'Black Leadership Programme' 2022!
