


Opportunities to connect with NTU talent

Ashfield

Supported by the Government's Towns Fund, NTU has been awarded £3.8m to deliver the Enterprising Ashfield project, a comprehensive Start-up to Scale-up business support programme across the Kirkby-in-Ashfield and Sutton-in-Ashfield areas.

The programme will provide Entrepreneurs with industry insights and workshops, as well as funding for start-up support, coaching and mentoring designed to help your business grow. Talent support and grants of £1,250 will enable access to a six-week graduate placement if match-funded by the employer.

In addition, flexibly delivered courses will focus on upskilling the Ashfield workforce through courses covering digital and advanced manufacturing skills. NTU will also deliver a Digital Academy focusing on skills such as web design, social media marketing and search engine optimisation (SEO).
