Building sustainable supply chains with the **Net Zero Carbon Supplier Tool**

The Net Zero Carbon Supplier Tool (Tool) has been developed by Nottingham Trent University (NTU) and NETpositive Futures to allow universities to engage with their suppliers helping them to calculate and understand their own carbon footprint and develop carbon reduction action plans for free, whilst at the same time enabling universities to progress to net zero by developing robust supply chain carbon footprints, based on actual carbon data.



With many universities deploying the Tool across shared supply chains and suppliers only needing one account (selecting which universities they supply), the 'supplier and sector' collaboration is providing an innovative and efficient way for sustainability and carbon data to be shared by suppliers across the Higher Education (HE) sector.
