History of NTU

- 1843** The Nottingham Government School of Design opens.
- 1881** University College Nottingham is established on Shakespeare Street. The premises eventually become the Arkwright building.
- 1908** DH Lawrence receives his teaching certificate after studying in the Arkwright building.
- 1970** The merger of several colleges creates Trent Polytechnic, which is later renamed and rebranded as Nottingham Polytechnic in 1989.
- 1992** Nottingham Polytechnic is granted university status. Professor Ray Cowell is appointed the first Vice-Chancellor of the new Nottingham Trent University (NTU).
- 2003** Professor Neil Gorman becomes NTU's second Vice-Chancellor.
- 2008** Sir Michael Parkinson is appointed NTU's first Chancellor.
- 2011** Sir David Attenborough officially opens the regenerated Newton and Arkwright buildings on the City Campus.
- 2014** Professor Edward Peck becomes the University's third Vice-Chancellor. NTU voted University of the Year and wins the Postgraduate award at the Whatuni Student Choice Awards.
Kevin Cahill CBE is appointed NTU's second Chancellor.
- 2015** NTU receives its first Queen's Anniversary Prize for Higher and Further Education. It is the highest national honour for a UK university.
- 2017** Sir John Peace becomes NTU's third Chancellor.
NTU wins UK University of the Year at the Times Higher Education Awards.
- 2018** NTU is named Modern University of the Year in The Times and Sunday Times Good University Guide 2018 for the first time (receiving the award once more in 2023).
NTU celebrates the 175th anniversary of its founding as the Nottingham Government School of Design.
- 2019** NTU is named University of the Year at The Guardian University Awards 2019. NTU wins University of the Year at the UK Social Mobility Awards.
- 2020** NTU in Mansfield opened its doors in September 2020 with 193 new students studying 12 courses.
- 2021** NTU receives the Queen's Anniversary Prize for Higher and Further Education for the second time since 2016.
- 2022** The Health and Allied Professions Centre opens at Clifton Campus – a specialist learning space for nursing and paramedical students.
- 2023** NTU voted University of the Year and wins the Postgraduate award at the Whatuni Student Choice Awards.
The Princess of Wales visits our Clifton Campus to mark World Mental Health Day.
The University is again awarded Gold (after receiving it for the first time in 2017) in the government's Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF) for delivering consistently outstanding teaching, learning and outcomes for students.
NTU opens London campus offering a focused portfolio of undergraduate and postgraduate degree courses designed for the creative and digital industries.
- 2024** The Postgraduate Centre opens, featuring state-of-the-art technology and modern teaching and social spaces.
The Design & Digital Arts building officially opens, placing Nottingham as a UK hub for film, television, animation, UX design, games design, graphic design and more.
We congratulate our first NTU London graduates.
- 2025** Professor Dave Petley becomes the University's fourth Vice-Chancellor, and President.
- 2026** NTU named by the Daily Mail University Guide 2026 as Sports University of the Year.

Her screen work includes major roles in both British and international productions. Recent appearances include DCS Carol Shaw in the BBC series *Ludwig* starring David Mitchell, and Lady Coote in Netflix's *The Seven Dials Mystery*. She is widely recognised for her performance as Pauline in the BAFTA winning BBC comedy *Mum*, written and directed by Stefan Golaszewski.

Sian Hampton served as Chief Executive Officer of Archway Learning Trust from 2017 to 2025, leading a vibrant and diverse educational community across Nottingham and Derby. Under her leadership, the Trust grew from a single school into a thriving family of eight secondary and three primary schools, educating over 9,000 pupils. Today, Archway employs more than 1,500 staff and has an annual turnover in excess of £74 million, with a strong commitment to inclusive education and opportunity for all learners.

Archway Learning Trust has historic roots dating back to 1706 at St Mary's Church, Nottingham, originally founded to support the education of disadvantaged children. That founding mission continues today, with 44% of pupils classified as disadvantaged and 30% speaking English as an additional language. The Trust also includes specialist SEND provision, Sixth Form centres, and a School-Centred Initial Teacher Training programme.

During her tenure, Sian Hampton led significant school improvement, including transforming schools from Inadequate and Requires Improvement to Good, overseeing major capital development projects, and expanding the Trust through new schools and academies. Archway schools now include nationally recognised provision, with Bluecoat Wollaton Academy achieving World Class Schools status.

Born and raised in Nottingham, Kim's route to literary success was anything but conventional. Dr Allan Njanji

Dr Allan Njanji is an award-nominated filmmaker, researcher, and campaign strategist whose work focuses on refugee rights, migration policy, and the role of lived experience in shaping social change.

Beginning his career in documentary filmmaking and video journalism, Allan has used storytelling to highlight issues of social justice and amplify the voices of displaced communities. His work has been widely recognised for raising awareness and contributing to public understanding of migration and refugee experiences.

A graduate of Nottingham Trent University, Allan holds a PhD in Refugee Studies and a Master's degree in Documentary Journalism. His academic research has explored refugee agency, voice, and self-representation, reflecting his commitment to ensuring that people with lived experience play a central role in shaping policy, research, and public discourse.

Alongside his research, Allan has held communications and leadership roles across the refugee sector, including positions with Notts TV, Nottingham Refugee Forum, and Nottingham Trent University. He currently serves as Regional Campaigns Manager at Asylum Matters, a national charity advocating for fair and compassionate asylum policy in the UK.

Recognised nationally and internationally for his contributions, Allan was named one of The Big Issue's 100 Changemakers of 2026 and has contributed to global discussions on migration, including speaking at the Humanitarian Congress Berlin. His work continues to bridge filmmaking, policy, research, and advocacy to promote more humane responses to migration.



Dominic Portman

Dominic Portman is an entrepreneur and technology innovator whose work focuses on the future of digital retail and online marketplaces. A graduate of Nottingham Trent University, he completed a First Class Honours degree in Psychology in 2012, combining his interest in human behaviour with a passion for enterprise that first developed through NTU's business incubator, The Hive.

While still a student, Dominic launched a part-time fancy dress business, gaining hands-on entrepreneurial experience that helped lay the foundations for his future career. After graduating, he went on to found Boulevard, a retail technology company that connects brands, distributors and digital marketplaces through an innovative platform and operating model.

Under Dominic's leadership, Boulevard has achieved annual sales of more than £9 million, secured over £3 million in institutional investment, and created employment opportunities for more than 300 people. The company continues to innovate, including through the development of a platform designed to connect emerging digital marketplaces with access to more than one million products.

Dominic's achievements have earned national recognition, including winning Scale-Up Entrepreneur of the Year for the Midlands at the 2023 Great British Entrepreneur Awards. He has also contributed to wider discussions on UK business, entrepreneurship and digital trade, including participation in business events at 10 Downing Street and hosting roundtable discussions at major UK political conferences.

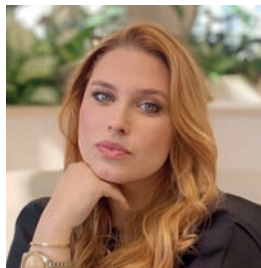
A keen sportsman and accomplished chess player, Simon has built an international career leading transformation and innovation across a wide range of retail sectors, including fashion, homewares, gifting

She holds an LLM in Health Law and Ethics from Nottingham Trent University, awarded through the Commonwealth Shared Scholarship in 2021, and an LLB from Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology in Ghana.

Deladem is actively engaged in public service and community impact. She has worked with the National Justice Museum in Nottingham, facilitating programmes addressing knife crime through the Choices and Consequences initiative, and is a Community Health Advocate with The Essential Baby Company CIC. She also contributes to research initiatives focused on improving inclusion of Black and other minoritised groups in UK research.

An NTU Alumni Volunteer since 2022, she supports student recruitment, outreach, and mentoring in both Ghana and Nottingham.

Her work is driven by a commitment to justice reform, youth development, and restorative approaches rooted in accountability and community healing.

Sunita Passi

Sunita Passi is a wellbeing practitioner, educator and entrepreneur specialising in Ayurvedic medicine and holistic health. A graduate of Nottingham Trent University, where she completed an MA in Investigative Journalism, her career has evolved from journalism and broadcasting into health, education and practitioner training.

She is the founder of Tri-Dosha, a natural skincare and wellness brand, and leads a practitioner training academy supporting therapists to build sustainable wellbeing practices. Her work combines traditional Ayurvedic principles with modern approaches to

mental health, resilience and personal development.

Laura Temple

Laura Temple is a solicitor and legal aid specialist whose career has been dedicated to improving access to justice for vulnerable and disadvantaged communities. A graduate of Nottingham Law School, she studied Law with Criminology at Nottingham Trent University, completing a year-long placement with a local solicitors' practice that sparked her passion for legal aid work.

During her time at NTU, Laura was an active volunteer, serving as a course representative, student ambassador and participant in legal outreach initiatives. Her commitment to supporting others continued

after graduation while studying the Legal Practice Course, alongside working for Remedi, a charity supporting restorative justice programmes for young offenders.

Following qualification as a solicitor, Laura built extensive expertise in housing law, progressing from junior caseworker to Legal Aid Agency supervisor. She later played a leading role in establishing North Yorkshire Citizens Advice and Law Centre, helping to address the shortage of legal aid provision in the region. Working with colleagues and sector specialists, she helped create a new legal service from the ground up, securing legal aid contracts in housing and immigration.

Now Director of Legal and Specialist Services, Laura continues to champion access to justice and community-based legal support. In 2024, her team was shortlisted for a Legal Aid Lawyer of the Year Award, recognising its outstanding contribution to the sector.
