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



The choice of ethics

The popularity of business Master's degrees has seen considerable growth in the subjects offered for study in recent years. In the research for Tomorrow's Masters, respondents are offered 54 potential Master's degree subjects across four groups and asked which they would be interested in studying.

Top of the list this year is Business Forecasting and Modelling, chosen by 36% of respondents with Business Ethics and Digital Marketing just behind, chosen by 35% of the respondents. The remainder of the top six subject choices is made up of technology-related degrees with Artificial Intelligence and Business chosen by 34% of the study respondents, E-commerce by 33% and Data Analytics by 31%.




