How to make the most of your open day in 4 steps

1. Check-in

When you arrive, head to the Main Hall (M) or Bramley building (B). Here you can check-in ✓, chat to our friendly staff and grab a tote bag. Find complimentary refreshments in the Refectory (R). Use our handy campus map on pages 6 – 7 to make your way around the event.

2. Get to know your course

Find out more about your course by attending a subject talk, taking a tour of facilities and visiting your subject hub to chat with staff and current students. Timings for talks, tours and subject hub availability can be found on the open day timetable on pages 8 – 11.

3. Explore our facilities

Take a student-led campus tour to see some of the buildings and spaces you'll be using at NTU. Tours leave from outside the Library (L) and are available from **9 am** with the last tour leaving at **2.30 pm**. There's no need to book and you can ask your Student Ambassador questions throughout.

4. Meet your support staff

Find out more about life at NTU – head to the Main Hall (M) from **9 am** to meet the people committed to making your time at NTU as comfortable, happy and productive as it can be.

What's on?

Subject talks – Presented by staff who teach your subject, this is your opportunity to find out more about the modules you'll study, the potential work placements available, as well as what you can do after your course.

Campus and subject tours – Facility tours run throughout the day, and are led by Student Ambassadors and staff. These tours will give you the opportunity to ask questions and provide a deeper insight into student life at NTU and Brackenhurst.

Courses and admissions – Find out more about your course, get advice on the application process, entry requirements and what you'll need for your application.

Employability – Find out about the range of part time work and career development opportunities available to students at NTU.

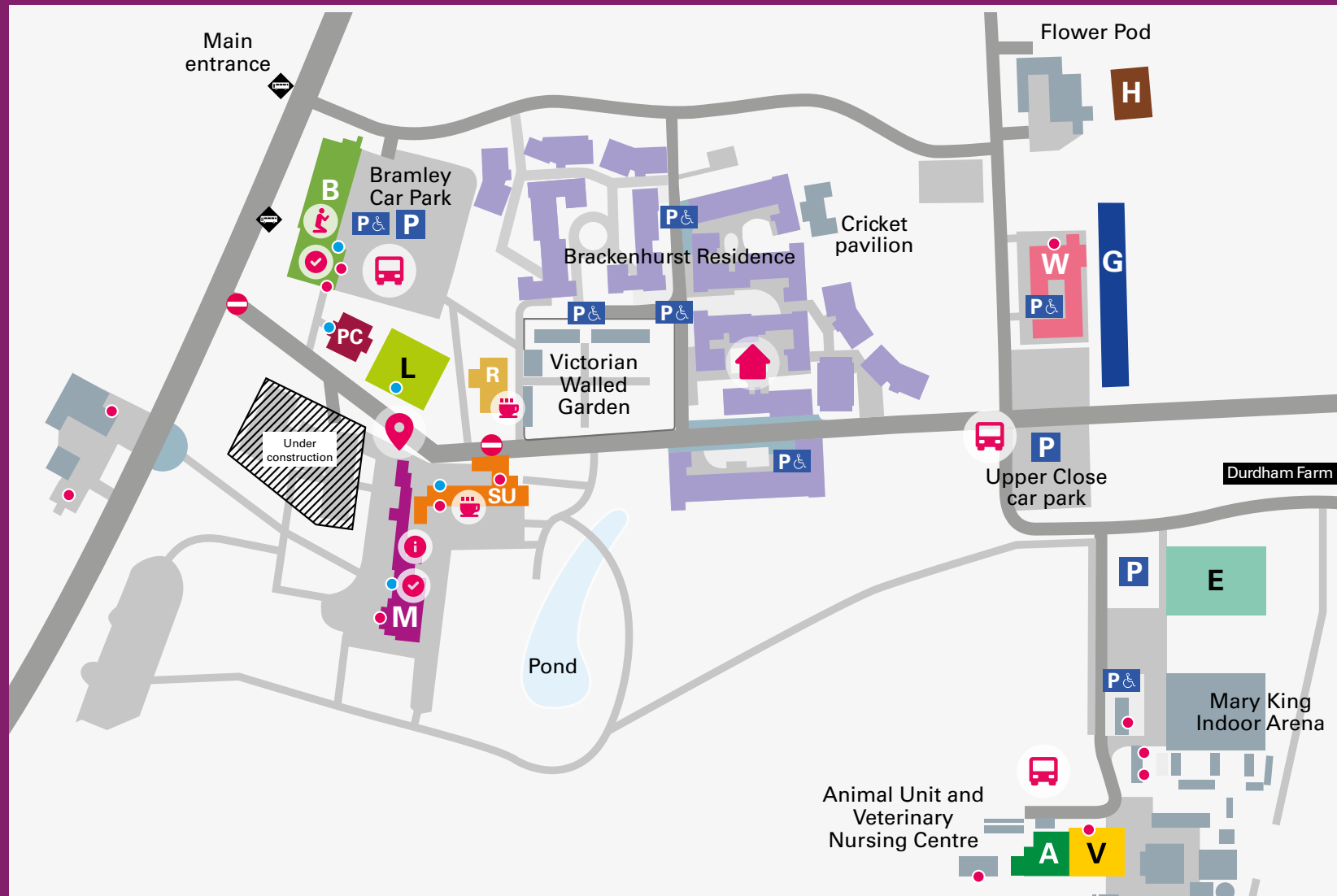
Filming and photography take place throughout our events and is used for publicity purposes. If you do not want your image to be used, please notify a member of staff so this can be actioned.
