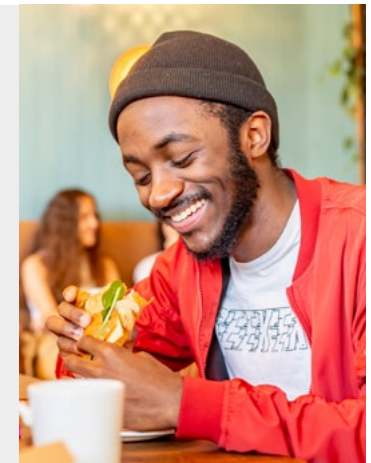
Food and drink

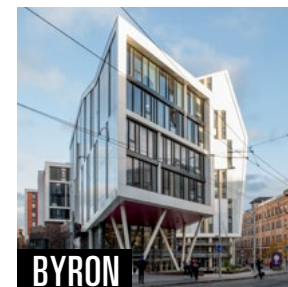

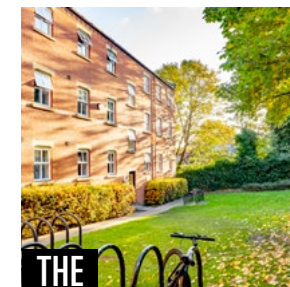

TRAVELLING BETWEEN CAMPUSES



City to Clifton:

- **By bus** (approx. 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.
- **By car** (approx. 15 minutes): Drive to Clifton using satnav postcode **NG11 8NS**. Free parking available on site.

City to Brackenhurst:

- **By bus** (approx. 45 minutes): Board the lilac Pathfinder number 26 bus on King Street (K1). This service is not free, visit nctx.co.uk for fares and timetables.
- **By car** (approx. 35 minutes): Drive to Brackenhurst using satnav postcode **NG25 0QF**.

Shuttle bus for Metronome, Confetti X and Digital Media Hub:

- **By shuttle bus** (approx. 5 minutes): Take the free shuttle bus outside the Dryden building (D) and on Beck Street from **8.40 am – 3 pm**. Shuttle runs every 20 minutes to both ends of City Campus.
- **On foot**: 15 minute walk from Shakespeare street. Visit the campus and city tours leaving point (I) for support with directions or search for 'Metronome, Huntingdon Street' in your maps app.

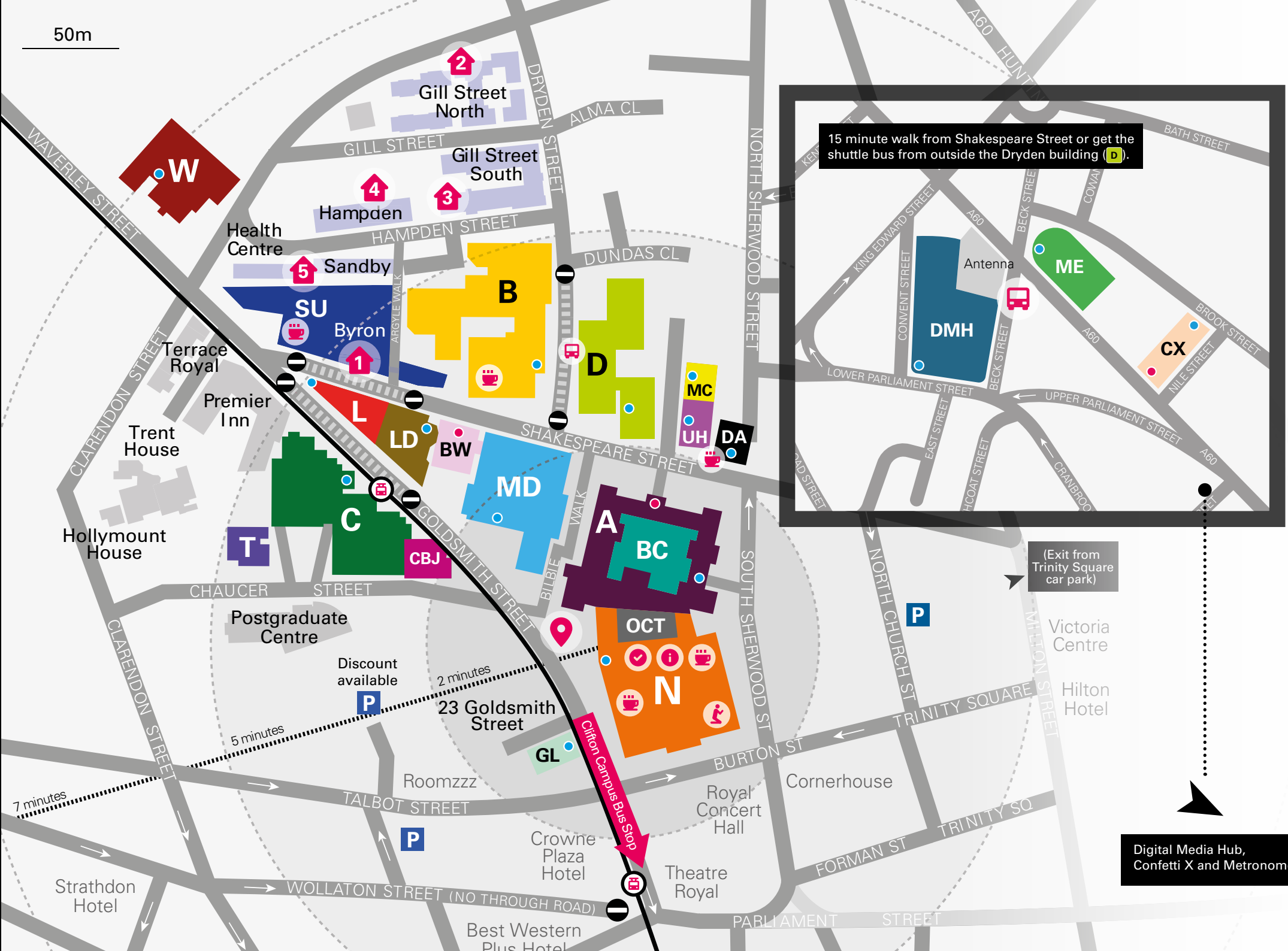
CITY CAMPUS MAP
