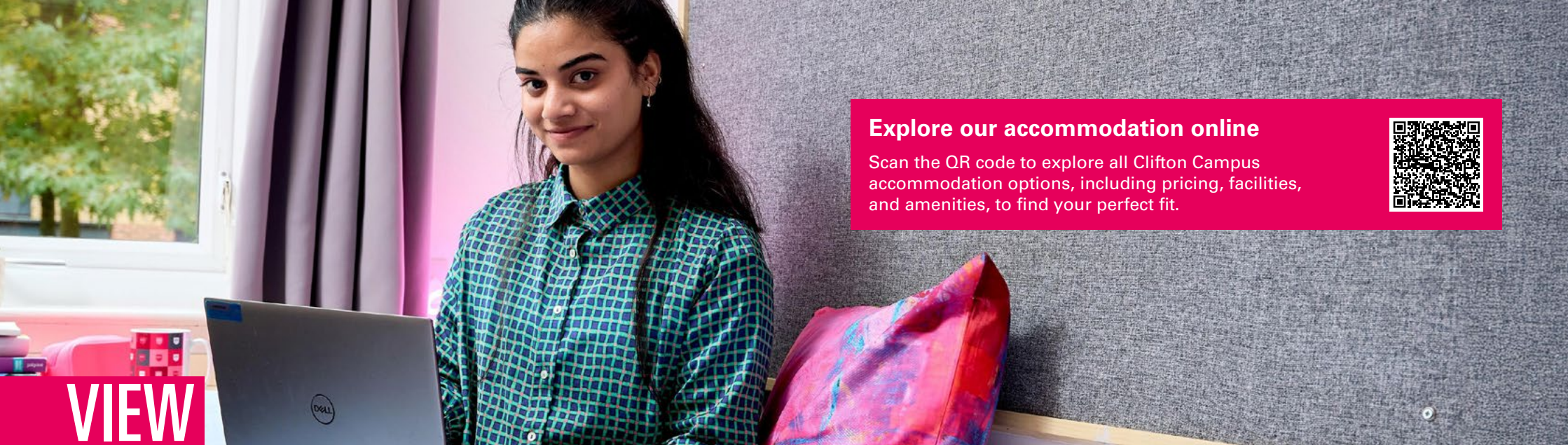

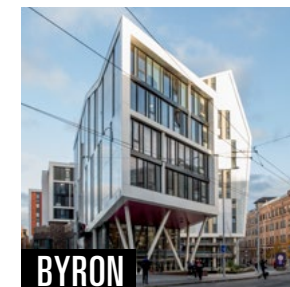

TRAVELLING BETWEEN CAMPUSES



Clifton to City:

- **By bus** (approx. 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from the NTU Clifton (CL93) stop and get off at Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.

- **By car** (approx 15 mins): The closest and largest parking facilities to our City Campus are:

Talbot Street (NG1 5GG)
Trinity Square (NG1 4BH)
The Victoria Centre (NG1 3PR)

Alternatively, you could use one of the city's park and ride services and continue your journey by tram. The closest site to the city is The Forest (**NG7 6AQ**), which is approx. a 20 minute drive from Clifton Campus, and then a 5 minute tram journey.

City to Clifton:

- **By bus** (approx. 30 minutes): Board the Nottingham City Transport (NCT) number 1 bus from Nottingham Beastmarket Hill (B2) in Old Market Square. Show your open day guide or booking confirmation for free travel.
- **By car** (approx. 15 minutes): Drive to Clifton using satnav postcode **NG11 8NS**. Free parking available on site.

Clifton to Brackenhurst:

- **By car** (approx. 50 minutes): Drive to Brackenhurst using satnav postcode **NG25 0QF**. Free parking available on site.

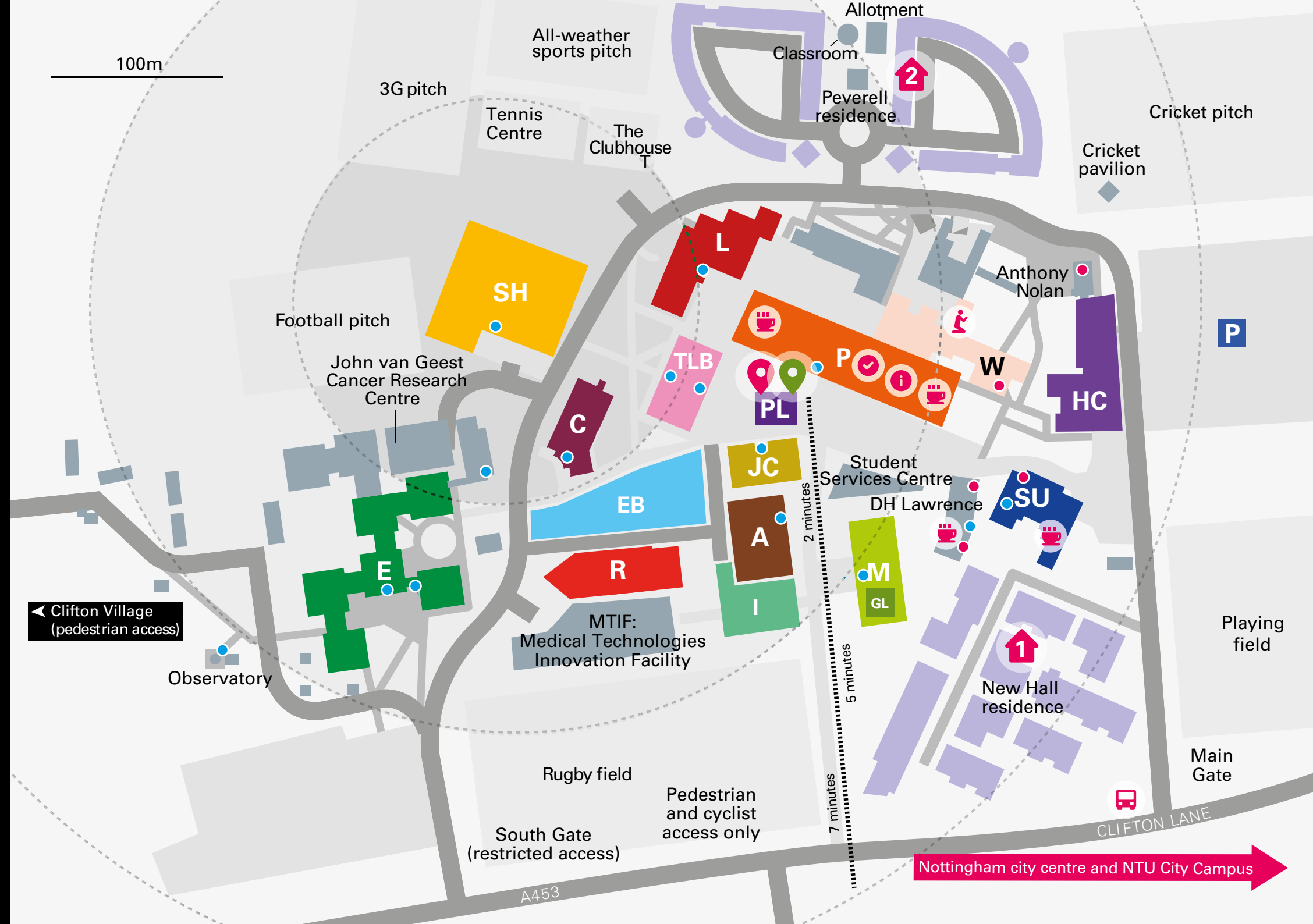
